On September 11, the top candidates for the Bundestag met at the invitation of the BWE and the WAB in Bremen with media representatives for a joint breakfast. The main focus of the discussion was on the topics of system integration, networks and workplace safety in Bremen and Bremerhaven.





# **Cuxhaven Appell 2.0**

On the same day, the economic and energy ministers and senators of the North German countries, the representatives of the offshore cities and associations jointly signed the Cuxhaven Appell 2.0. The central requirement is to lift the cover for the expansion of offshore wind energy. The Federal Government's

costs for the limitation of the expansion are rejected by the first call for tenders.
