Strengthen the Transatlantic Cooperation

Upon invitation of the German-American Chamber of Commerce, the German-American Offshore Wind Symposium took place in New York in June 2018. German and American experts met to accelerate international knowledge transfer and to discuss opportunities for cooperations. Andreas Wellbrock praised the German logistics and port infrastructure as a role model for the American market. The WAB Managing Director will intensify the transatlantic cooperation in the upcoming months: "The United States will be an important offshore market in the future. The expansion of the industry in the U.S. is politically intended due to the employment creation. Our members can profit from this development. The WAB wants to build bridges by planning further activities."

Lecture at the Industry Day in North Rhine-Westphalia

Andreas Wellbrock's speech at the Industry Day in Düsseldorf in June 2018 demonstrated that the cap of renewable energies does not match the government's proclaimed target of a 65 % share for renewable energies in the electricity sector until 2030. "The renewable energies sector is asked to further emphasize and illustrate the link between fossil energy generation and the occurrence of serious storms to the public in order to increase the need for action of the Federal Government," Wellbrock said.

On June 26, the Women of WindEnergy visited the WAB. The two wind women Nike Fuchs and Monika Marquardt presented the work of the WAB. The Women of WindEnergy reported on their upcoming mentoring program, which will be held for the fifth time.


