And at this year's WINDFORCE Conference on 21 and 22 May in Bremerhaven, the political message was also the focus of attention: Local politicians and industry representatives called for the removal of the expansion cover of the offshore wind industry and an expansion of the expansion targets to 35 gigawatts (GW) by 2035. WAB Interim Managing Director Heike Winkler said on the sidelines of the event that the industry now needs a special contribution of 1.5 GW quickly.

WINDFORCE Conference: Industry sends common signal to Berlin | Local politicians hand over "Declaration of Bremen"

For the I5th time, the industry came together for the WINDFORCE Conference on the 21st and 22nd of May in Bremerhaven. With the help of the "Declaration of Bremen", the organizer WAB sends an urgent call for action to Berlin politicians and in particular to Federal Minister of Economics Peter Altmaier. The core requirement of the declaration is that the expansion path for the offshore wind industry must be increased to 35 gigawatts (GW) by 2035. In his welcoming speech, WAB Managing Director Andreas Wellbrock also called for a short-term special contribution of at least 1.5 GW.

wind:reseach published study results

The offshore wind industry, which has been growing for years, has currently generated 24,500 jobs in Germany and a total turnover of 9 billion euros last year, according to the recently published study "Value Creation of Offshore Wind Energy in Germany" by the research institute wind:research. If the current expansion target is maintained, the industry is threatened with a loss of more than 8,000 jobs, but if the expansion target is increased, the number of jobs could increase by up to 10,000.
