
Heike Winkler was also a live guest at Radio Bremen on 28 July. You can see the television interview here.

Innovation workshops on the topics of securing skilled workers

Part-time wind studies: Apply now

Prospective students can apply for the "Further Training Course in Wind Energy Technology and Management" of the Centre for Wind Energy Research (ForWind) at the University of Oldenburg until 4 September. The part-time course imparts interdisciplinary knowledge on technology, economics, law and project planning in the wind energy sector at master level.

In the academic year 2019/2020 the proven concept will be supplemented by a unit "Post-EEG Business Models". This unit will deal with the marketing of wind power beyond the German Renewable Energy Sources Act (EEG) and sector coupling. In addition, the topics of digitisation and foreign markets will be integrated into existing units.

The eleven-month training course is aimed at specialists and managers from various disciplines in the wind energy sector as well as career changers from other branches of industry. Graduates are able to understand the complexity of wind energy projects and implement them competently. They gain interdisciplinary skills to successfully design and operate wind farms.
